Professor the Hon Gareth Evans AC QC, Australian National University (10.30am)

Professor Evans has been Chancellor of the Australian National University since January 2010 and is also an Honorary Professorial Fellow. He was a member of the Australian Parliament for 21 years in total and was a Cabinet Minister for 13 years, holding the offices of Minister for Resources and Energy and Foreign Minister among others. Professor Evans has held international policymaking roles on a number of advisory bodies to the United Nations and, from 2008 until 2010, he co-chaired the Australian and Japanese sponsored International Commission on Nuclear Non-proliferation and Disarmament. Professor Evans is the Patron and Emeritus Convenor of the Asia Pacific Leadership Network for Nuclear Non-proliferation and Disarmament and, until earlier this year, was also Chair of the International Advisory Board for the Centre for Nuclear Non-proliferation and Disarmament in Canberra.
