## Mr David Knox, BSc (Hons) Mech Eng, MBA, FIE Aust, FTSE (2pm)

Mr David Knox has over 30 years of experience in the global oil and gas industry. He was the Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of Santos from July 2008 to November 2015, having been appointed Acting Chief Executive Officer in March 2008. He joined Santos in September 2007 as Executive Vice President Growth Businesses. Mr Knox was the Managing Director for BP Developments in Australasia from 2003 to 2007. He previously held senior positions with BP in Australia, the United Kingdom and Pakistan, and management and engineering roles at ARCO and Shell in the United States, the Netherlands, the United Kingdom and Norway.

Mr Knox is currently a Director of the Migration Council Australia, Chairman of the Adelaide Botanic Gardens Foundation and Chair of the CSIRO Energy Strategic Advisory Committee. He is also a member of the Commonwealth Science Council, Business Council of Australia, University of Queensland Industry Engagement Committee, Great Barrier Reef Foundation, the Royal Institute of Australia, the Trade and Investment Policy Advisory Council and the UK University College London Advisory Committee. Mr Knox is a Fellow of the Australian Institute of Mechanical Engineering and was elected in November 2012 as a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Technological Sciences and Engineering.
