Mr Fisher is an Estate Safety Assurance Manager at the NDA in the UK. In this role, he liaises with regulators, managers and operators at the NDA's nuclear sites on a variety of safety issues, including radiation protection. He has over 20 years' experience in nuclear and radiation industries, including as an operator at nuclear facilities and as a Nuclear Regulator for the Environment Agency, where he inspected radiation protection measures in place at those facilities. Mr Fisher is the NDA representative at a number of industry groups in the UK, including the National Dose Assessment Working Group and the Nuclear Sites Energy Forum.
